



New By-law No. 508

Concerning snow removal contractors

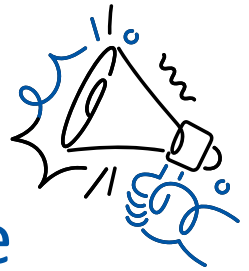
Objectives



Essential for safety and traffic flow in our territory, snow removal activities can have a direct impact on many aspects of winter life, including road safety, access to properties, and the comfort of residents. This by-law aims to regulate snow removal activities on public roads, private driveways, and parking lots to ensure they are carried out under the best possible conditions, taking into account the needs of the Senneville community.

The snow removal contractor must also comply with the applicable laws and regulations, including the Highway Safety Code, RLRQ. C-24.2, and its regulations, By-law No. 343 concerning parking, traffic and road safety, as well as By-law No. 482 on nuisances and sanitation.

New feature



Any contractor wishing to carry out snow removal work within the territory of Senneville must now obtain a permit. This permit, which costs \$50 per motorized vehicle used, is required for any work conducted on public property. Anyone who violates this by-law is subject to a fine ranging from \$300 to \$4,000. Property owners who hire a snow removal contractor must ensure that the contractor holds a valid permit issued by the municipality.

Permit

The permit is valid from November 1 of the current year to October 31 of the following year. To apply, simply provide the required documents and information as requested in the online form.
